3. Background

- **3.1.** Scotland's Future Skills Action Plan was published in 2018. A summary of the plan is available via the following link <u>https://economicactionplan.mygov.scot/future-skills/overview/</u>
- **3.2.** We have been working closely with SDS over the last year to progress the implementation of this Action Plan within a regional context. For example, work in respect of Skills Alignment features within our Regional Programme of Action for 2019-20.
- **3.3.** The 5-step skills alignment model provides a framework for our work. Paul Zealey (SDS) will provide a presentation on Step 1 of this process which focusses on the demand for skills in the Glasgow region. Work has also taken place on Step 2 of this process which looks at the current supply of skills training. It is expected that the report on Step 2 of the process will be available in February. With this evidence base we can begin to look towards step 3 of the process.
