1. Executive Summary

1.1. This report provides an update in respect of the Flexible Workforce Development Fund (FWDF).

2. Recommendations

- **2.1.** The Committee is recommended to **note** that:
 - The value of flexible workforce funding, to be claimed by the colleges on 30 November 2024, is £33,628
 - A further claim (£13,414) is expected from City of Glasgow College in early 2025.
 - If there are no further claims by 31 March 2025, any remaining funds may be repurposed for an alternative use.

3. Report

- **3.1.** The funding allocation for flexible workforce activity was provided up to 31 July 2023. Therefore, any remaining activity since this date relates to legacy contracts.
- **3.2.** A further claim was submitted by City of Glasgow College in November 2024. This resulted in a payment of £53,509 to the college.
- **3.3.** As time passes there are fewer and fewer legacy contracts being delivered by the Glasgow colleges (for activity contracted in 2022-23). The residual funding, that remains to be claimed on 30 November 2024, is £33,628.
- **3.4.** A further claim (for £13,414) is expected to be received from City of Glasgow College at the beginning of 2025. Following the payment of this claim, the unpaid funds are expected to be modest, at around £20,000.
- **3.5.** If there are no further claims by 31 March 2025, any remaining funds may be re-purposed for an alternative use
