## E-resources

# **Box of Broadcasts**

This service allows you to record TV and radio programmes over a seven-day period and watch archived programmes online. Covers all subject areas.

# **Building Cost Information Service**

Provides accurate and updated building cost and tender price information for the construction industry and property market. Only accessible at City campus. You must turn off pop up blockers to access this resource. Please ask library staff for the username & password.

#### Credo Reference

Gives access to the Dictionary of Construction and Architecture.

#### **IHS Technical Indexes**

Provides access to the *Specify-It* and the *Construction Information*Service which provides access to industry information, British Standards and legislation for building, construction, engineering and design. Also includes online access to the *Architects' Journal* and *Construction News*.

- <u>Masonry Conservation Research Group</u> Abstracts and excerpts from the Masonry Conservation Group based at the Robert Gordon University.
- <u>Twentieth Century Society</u> Site showcasing some of Britain's best buildings under threat and in need of conservation.
- <u>The Urban Conservation Glossary</u> Reference source provided by the University of Dundee for anyone involved in or interested in the conservation of the built environment with links to other related websites.
